

1 QUALIFICATION STATEMENT OF

2 RODNEY E. BOLING

3 Witness for the Bonneville Power Administration

4 *Q. Please state your name, employer, and business address.*

5 A. My name is Rodney E. (Rod) Boling. I am employed by the Bonneville Power Administration
6 (BPA), 905 NE. 11th Avenue, Portland, Oregon.

7 *Q. In what capacity are you employed?*

8 A. I am a Financial Analyst in the Financial Forecasting Section of Financial Planning,
9 Financial Services Group.

10 *Q. Please state your educational background.*

11 A. I received a B.A. degree in Business and Economics from Western Washington State
12 College (now Western Washington University) in 1967. I received a M.S. in Agricultural
13 Economics (emphasis in Resource Economics) from Washington State University in 1978.

14 *Q. Please state your professional qualifications.*

15 A. I was first employed by BPA as a Public Utilities Specialist (Rates) in 1982. For the 1982
16 rate case, I contributed to the Rates Environmental Impact Statement.

17 For the 1985 BPA rate case, I was technical lead for the nonfirm energy and surplus
18 firm power rate schedules. Following the 1985 rate case, I was lead staff coordinator with
19 the California Energy Commission (CEC) as the CEC developed its Energy Resource
20 Plan VI.

21 Since 1986, I have been employed as a Financial Analyst. I have been responsible
22 for or have assisted in BPA intervention efforts in several investor-owned utility (IOU) rate
23 cases and merger hearings before all four state regulatory commissions. In addition, I have
24 led or assisted in Residential Exchange buyouts, "in lieu" negotiations, billing credits,
25 evaluations of resource and energy service company proposals to BPA, Residential Purchase
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1 and Sale Agreement (RPSA) contract negotiations, and represented BPA in IOU integrated
2 resource plan and decoupling collaboratives.

3 *Q. Please state your experience as a witness in previous proceedings.*

4 A. I was a witness in BPA's 1996 rate proceedings.
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
