3 Witness for the Bonneville Power Administration

4 *Q. Please state your name, employer, and business address.*

5 A. My name is Margaret E. Pedersen. I am employed by the Bonneville Power Administration
6 (BPA), 905 NE. 11th Avenue, Portland, Oregon.

7 *Q. In what capacity are you employed?*

8 A. I am an Industry Economist in the Transmission and Reserve Services Group.

9 *Q. Please state your educational background.*

10 A. I received an undergraduate degree in Economics from Pepperdine University, and a Master
11 of Management degree from Willamette University.

12 *Q. Please summarize your professional experience.*

13 A. I was initially employed at BPA in June 1991, as a Public Utilities Specialist Student
14 Trainee in the Planning Branch while completing my Masters degree at Willamette
15 University. Upon completion of my degree in December 1991 through May 1997, I was
16 employed by BPA as an Industry Economist in the Long-Term Forecasting Section which
17 was integrated into the Market Research Group. As a Public Utilities Specialist in the
18 Long-Term Forecasting Section, I was responsible for forecasting commercial sector
19 end-use energy demand in the Pacific Northwest. I also was responsible for analyzing the
20 impacts on BPA utility sales for the 1993 *Wholesale Power and Transmission Rate*
21 *Adjustment: Final Environmental Assessment and the Business Plan: Draft Environmental*
22 *Impact Statement.*

23 Since May 1997, I have been employed as an Industry Economist in the
24 Transmission and Reserve Services Group in the Power Business Line. I am responsible for
25 managing short-term transmission inventory and developing transmission expense budgets.
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1 *Q. Please state your experience as a witness in previous proceedings.*

2 A. I was a witness in BPA's 1996 rate proceedings.

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
