

1 QUALIFICATION STATEMENT OF

2 ALLEN L. BURNS

3 Witness for the Bonneville Power Administration

4 *Q. Please state your name, employer, and business address.*

5 A. My name is Allen L. Burns. I am employed by the Bonneville Power Administration
6 (BPA), 905 NE. 11th Avenue, Portland, Oregon.

7 *Q. In what capacity are you employed?*

8 A. I am the Vice President, Bulk Power Marketing for the Power Business Line (PBL).

9 *Q. Please state your educational background.*

10 A. I received a B.S. in Electrical Engineering from the University of Portland in 1977, and a
11 M.S. degree in Electrical Engineering from Arizona State University in 1983. I am a
12 Registered Professional Engineer in the State of Oregon.

13 *Q. Please summarize your professional experience.*

14 A. I was employed as an Electrical Engineer from 1978 through 1985 and held several
15 positions involving the planning and design of BPA's high voltage transmission grid.

16 From 1985 to 1987, I was the Chief of BPA's Structural and Electrical Design
17 Branch.

18 From 1988 to 1994, I was Chief of the Transmission Branch, Division of Contracts
19 and Rates, where I was responsible for managing and directing the negotiation of BPA
20 transmission contracts, developing transmission policy, and developing and establishing
21 BPA's transmission rates for both main grid and intertie facilities.

22 I was the investor-owned utility (IOU) Segment Manager from May 1994 to
23 December 1995, and was responsible for all policies, products and services, and rate issues
24 related to BPA's Northwest IOU customers. I was then BPA Trading Floor Manager
25 responsible for the sales of BPA surplus power totaling \$500 to \$600 million/year.

1 I was recently appointed the Vice President, Bulk Power Marketing in the PBL and I
2 am responsible for policy, product and rate development for public, IOUs, Direct Service
3 Industries, and extraregional customers.

4 *Q. Please state your experience as a witness in previous proceedings.*

5 A. Yes. In 1996 I was on the Residential Exchange Panel, and in the early 90's, I was a witness
6 for the 7(i) proceedings on Third AC Non-Federal Participation.
