Subject: Personally Owned Vehicle Mileage Reimbursement Rate Change

The General Services Administration has released Federal Travel Regulation Bulletin 11-03, which changes the reimbursable amounts for use of Personally Owned Vehicles (POV) while performing official business travel. These new rates will be reflected in the GovTrip travel management system.

Effective January 1, 2011, the mileage rate for use of:

- Personally Owned Automobile – increased to \$.51 per mile
- Personally Owned Automobile when Government Owned Vehicle (GOV) is authorized - changed to \$.19 per mile (*Note: There will no longer be two different mileage rates for use of POV when authorized and committed or not committed to use a GOV. There will be one reimbursable rate when a GOV is authorized for Temporary Duty or local travel and POV is used.*)
- Personally Owned Motorcycle – increased to \$.48 per mile
- Personally Owned Aircraft – remains \$1.29 per mile.
