The U.S. Embassy reported a robbery recently in the first district of Vienna. The victim was approached by two men on a small side street and was pushed against a building. The tactics used by these criminals were threat of force and intimidation. This can be characterized as a crime of opportunity. The police have reported that there is an increasing number of this type of crime in the first district. It is suggested that one should avoid isolated streets or alleys, keep one's eyes up, maintain situational awareness and, if possible, to walk with another person.
