The Department of Defense (DoD) obligated \$126.4M during the week ending July 10, 2009, bringing the cumulative obligation Recovery Act funds to \$1,426.6M. The \$1,426.2M in obligations include \$1,218.1M for the Facilities Sustainment, Restoration and Modernization (FSRM) program, \$143.5M for the Military Construction Program, \$61.4M for the Near Term Energy-Efficie Technologies Program and \$3.6M for the Expanded Homeowners Assistance Program (HAP). These obligations represent 11 of all DoD Recovery Act Funds received and reflect over 1,190 contracts to non-Federal vendors. Of the contracts awarded, of 82% were awarded to small businesses (67% of contract dollars).	August 31. nt 0.2% vver
The Army obligated \$29.0M this week for multiple FSRM projects, for a cumulative obligation total for all programs of \$343.8M Obligations included cooperative agreements between the Army National Guard and the states of \$8.6M with NY and \$1.7M v HI; \$1.7M for drainage repair at Fort Huachuca, AZ; and repairs and upgrades to bachelor officer quarters at Camp Ripley, Mt 2 Leonard Wood, MO, and Camp Clark, MO.	/ith expected in the next few weeks. , Ft.
The Navy had a net increase of obligations of \$47.8M this week for a cumulative obligation total of \$325.3M. New obligations \$33.0M for Military Construction projects included \$23.0M for an energy conservation/alternative energy contract for photovolt systems at Hampton Roads, VA and \$9.7M for a child development center at Naval Support Activity Mid-South, TN. Obligatio of \$13.7M for Near Term Energy-Efficient Technologies Program projects included \$13.0M for hybrid electric drive for DDG-51 The net of \$1.2M for FSRM projects included obligations of \$13.4M for multiple projects at both Camp Lejeune, NC and Camp Pendelton, CA which was reduced by adjustments to obligations of \$12.2M for pre/post award contract support.	aic ns ·
The Air Force obligated \$49.2M this week for a cumulative obligation total of \$726.2M. The \$49.2M for current week obligatio included \$47.6M for multiple FSRM projects and \$1.6M for Near Term Energy-Efficient Technologies Program. The obligatio FSRM projects included \$14.2M at Eareckson Af for pavements; \$8.5M for energy, roofing, utilities, and facility improvements at Moody AFB, GA; \$5.6M in energy, quality-of-life, and facility projects at Andrews AFB, MD; \$2.7M in operations and energy projects at Peterson AFB, CO; and \$2.3M for energy, roofing, pavements, and facility projects at Kirtland AFB, NM. The Air Force also obligated \$1.6M for Near Term Energy-Effici 4 Technologies.	is for and ent
