Dear Mrs. Hercos:

The provisions of Section 1183(a)(1) of Title 8 of the United States Code make it unlawful for any slien to depart the United States unless such departure is in conformity with the rules and regulations issued under that Section. I now have reason to believe that you intend to depart from the United States in a manner which would be prejudicial to the interests of the United States. I further have reason to believe that your departure from the United States would fell within Part 215.3 of Title 8 of the Code of Peteral Magulations (nopy attached), and is therefore prohibited. Consequently, in accordance with the supportry vested as me under 8 d.F.R. 215.2(s) (any attached), you are hereby ordered that you shall not depart the United States until such time as this order is revoked.

In equipmenty with 8 C.F.R. 215.4, you have a right to a hearing before a apecial inquiry officer (imagration judge) reporting this order. A copy of the regulations describing the bearing process and your entitlement to representation during that process is attached.

Any such request for a hearing must be received by the undersigned at 595 Ale Hoene Benlevard, Remelulu, Edwaii 96813. If you do not make a timely request for such a hearing, this order aball become final fifteen (15) days from the date of service upon you.
