Her name is Jennifer Lynch and she will be working with Brookhaven's international community on expanding the existing ESOL classes and curriculum and assisting Brookhaven's foreign guests with communication-related issues.

Jennifer Lynch holds a Master of Arts degree in Teaching English as a Second Language (TESOL) from the State University of New York @ Stony Brook, where she later became professor of English as a Second Language. Jennifer has also taught at various schools in England and the United States.

The current ESOL program includes the following:

Language Interchange Program (LIP). This program is a nice way to informally learn or practice a language with someone who is fluent in that language. Contact Jennifer and she will match you up with a staff member, visitor, guest, or spouse who fits your language needs.

Monday Night Movie. Free movies will be shown every third Monday of the month at 7:30 p.m. in Berkner Hall. Movie selections will be listed in the Brookhaven Bulletin and posted in dormitories and other strategic spots at Brookhaven. This program is open to all: employees, visiting scientists, spouses or partners, students, and guests alike.

English for Speakers of Other Languages Classes. Free classes are offered daily at the Recreation Building. Contact Jennifer for details.
