

## Fixed Assets and Consumer Durable Goods for 2008–2011

The Bureau of Economic Analysis (BEA) produces statistics on fixed assets and consumer durable goods as part of its efforts to measure the wealth of the nation. Fixed assets are produced assets that are used repeatedly, or continuously, in processes of production for more than a year; consumer durable goods are tangible commodities purchased by consumers that can be used repeatedly and continuously over a period of 3 or more years.

New statistics on fixed assets and consumer durable goods for 2011, revised statistics for 2009 and 2010, and previously published statistics for 2008 are presented in this report. The statistics for 2009–2011 incorporate the

results of the 2012 annual revision of the national income and product accounts, which was released on July 27, 2012.<sup>1</sup> These statistics cover (1) the net stock of equipment and software and of structures owned by business and by government and (2) the net stock of durable goods owned by consumers. The statistics are presented in current dollars and in chain-type quantity indexes, in tables 1–7. In addition, table 1 presents the statistics in chained (2005) dollars.

The statistics on net stock, depreciation (consumption of fixed capital), and the average age of net stocks for 1925–2011 and on fixed investment for 1901–2011 are also available on the Web site.
