Here are just a few benefits for which you may be eligible:

- **The Job Opportunities for Low-Income Individuals (JOLI) Program** aims to test and evaluate ways of creating employment and business opportunities for individuals receiving Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) assistance. This program also encourages low-income individuals to become financially self-sufficient through self-employment, micro-enterprise, new business ventures and expansion of existing businesses.
- **Medicaid** is a healthcare program that helps pay for medical services for people with low incomes. If you are eligible for full Medicaid services, this program will pay healthcare providers such as doctors, hospitals and pharmacists that accept Medicaid.
- **One-Stop Career Centers** are at the heart of the new workforce investment system emerging under the Workforce Investment Act (WIA). These centers provide an integrated array of high-quality services so that job seekers and businesses can conveniently find the help they need in one place.
