EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE.

SECURITY THREATS TO UNITED STATES (U.S.) FLIGHT OPERATIONS IN YEMEN.

DUE TO TERRORIST ACTIVITIES AND CIVIL UNREST, THERE IS A SIGNIFICANT RISK TO CIVIL FLIGHT OPERATIONS IN YEMEN. SANAA INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT (OYSN) IS, IN PARTICULAR, A REGULAR TARGET.

U.S. OPERATORS PLANNING TO FLY IN YEMEN ARE ADVISED TO OBTAIN CURRENT THREAT INFORMATION AND MUST COMPLY WITH ALL APPLICABLE FAA REGULATIONS AND OPERATIONS SPECIFICATIONS.

ADDITIONALLY, U.S. OPERATORS ARE ENCOURAGED TO REPORT SECURITY INCIDENTS TO THE FAA AT +1 202-493-5833 OR +1 202-267-3333.

THE SECURITY CONDITIONS IN YEMEN FOR U.S. OPERATORS AND THE NEED FOR THIS SPECIAL NOTICE WILL BE RE-EVALUATED BY 1 OCTOBER 2012.
