

**MOTION TO RECOMMIT H.R. 3463**

M\_\_\_\_. \_\_\_\_\_ moves to recommit the bill H.R. 3463 to the Committee on House Administration with instructions to report the same back to the House forthwith with the following amendment:

Add at the end the following new section:

1 **SEC. 207. PROTECTIONS FOR ELDERLY, DISABLED, AND**  
2 **MILITARY VOTERS.**

3 Notwithstanding any provision of this Act or any  
4 amendment made by this Act, to the extent that the Elec-  
5 tion Assistance Commission is responsible for the adminis-  
6 tration or enforcement of any of the following provisions  
7 of law as of the Commission termination date described  
8 in section 1004(a) of the Help America Vote Act of 2002  
9 (as added by section 201(a)), any successor to the Com-  
10 mission shall remain responsible for the administration or  
11 enforcement of such provisions after such date:

12 (1) Any provision of law relating to the rights  
13 of the elderly to vote and cast ballots in elections for  
14 Federal office.

15 (2) Any provision of law relating to the rights  
16 of the elderly and other individuals who are reg-

1       istered to vote in elections for Federal office to ob-  
2       tain absentee ballots in such elections.

3           (3) Any provision of law relating to the access  
4       of the elderly, the disabled, and other individuals to  
5       polling places in elections for Federal office, includ-  
6       ing the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990.

7           (4) Any provision of law relating to the protec-  
8       tion of the rights of members of the uniformed serv-  
9       ices and overseas citizens to vote and cast ballots in  
10      elections for Federal office, including the Uniformed  
11      and Overseas Citizens Absentee Voting Act.

12          (5) Any other provision of law relating to the  
13      protection of the right of citizens of the United  
14      States to vote in elections for Federal office, includ-  
15      ing the Voting Rights Act of 1965.
