## Advance Report on Durable Goods Manufacturers' Shipments, Inventories and Orders July 2010

**New Orders.** New orders for manufactured durable goods in July increased \$0.6 billion or 0.3 percent to \$193.0 billion, the U.S. Census Bureau announced today. This increase followed two consecutive monthly decreases including a 0.1 percent June decrease. Excluding transportation, new orders decreased 3.8 percent. Excluding defense, new orders increased 0.3 percent. Transportation equipment, also up following two consecutive monthly decreases, had the largest increase, \$6.1 billion or 13.1 percent to \$52.6 billion. This was due to nondefense aircraft and parts, which increased \$4.0 billion.

**Shipments.** Shipments of manufactured durable goods in July, up four of the last five months, increased \$4.4 billion or 2.2 percent to \$200.6 billion. This followed a 0.2 percent June increase. Transportation equipment, also up four of the last five months, had the largest increase, \$3.4 billion or 6.9 percent to \$52.7 billion.

**Unfilled Orders.** Unfilled orders for manufactured durable goods in July, down following three consecutive monthly increases, decreased \$1.1 billion or 0.1 percent to \$802.8 billion. This followed a 0.1 percent June increase. Computers and electronic products, down following four consecutive monthly increases, had the largest decrease, \$0.5 billion or 0.4 percent to \$121.1 billion.

**Inventories.** Inventories of manufactured durable goods in July, up seven consecutive months, increased \$1.8 billion or 0.6 percent to \$311.2 billion. This followed a 1.3 percent June increase. Machinery, up five consecutive months, had the largest increase, \$0.9 billion or 1.9 percent to \$51.4 billion.

**Capital Goods.** Nondefense new orders for capital goods in July decreased \$1.8 billion or 2.8 percent to \$64.1 billion. Shipments increased \$0.9 billion or 1.4 percent to \$64.7 billion. Unfilled orders decreased \$0.6 billion or 0.1 percent to \$487.2 billion. Inventories increased \$1.0 billion or 0.8 percent to \$129.8 billion. Defense new orders for capital goods in July decreased \$0.2 billion or 2.2 percent to \$9.5 billion. Shipments decreased \$0.2 billion or 2.4 percent to \$9.5 billion. Unfilled orders decreased slightly to \$139.7 billion. Inventories increased slightly or 0.1 percent to \$17.9 billion.

**Revised June Data.** Revised seasonally adjusted June figures for all manufacturing industries were: new orders, \$408.6 billion (revised from \$406.4 billion); shipments, \$412.4 billion (revised from \$411.2 billion); unfilled orders, \$803.9 billion (revised from \$802.8 billion); and total inventories, \$520.7 billion (revised from \$520.0 billion).

Estimates of shipments and new orders are for the duration of the period, while estimates of unfilled orders and total inventories are for the end of the period. Not seasonally adjusted estimates of shipments and new orders include adjusted data for non-calendar reporters. Seasonally adjusted estimates include concurrent adjustments for holiday and trading-day differences, where appropriate, as well as seasonal variation, based on the results of the latest annual review of the model parameters. Estimates are not adjusted for price changes.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>2</sup> Based on advance sample. Estimates of manufacturers' shipments, inventories, and orders are subject to survey error and revision. One major component of survey error is nonsampling error, which includes errors of coverage, response and nonreporting. Since the survey panel is not a probability sample, estimates of sampling error cannot be calculated. <sup>&</sup>lt;sup>3</sup> The Capital Goods Industries include Nondefense: small arms and ordnance; farm machinery and equipment; construction machinery; mining, oil, and gas field machinery; industrial machinery; vending, laundry, and other machinery; photographic equipment; metalworking machinery; turbines and generators; other power transmission equipment; pumps and compressors; material handling equipment; all other machinery; electroic computers; computer storage devices; other computer peripheral equipment; communications equipment; search and navigation equipment; the reassuring, and control instruments; electrical equipment; other electrical equipment, appliances, and components; heavy duty trucks; aircraft; railroad rolling stock; ships and boats; office and institutional furniture; and medical equipment and supplies.

Defense Capital Goods include: small arms and ordnance, communications equipment, aircraft; missiles, space vehicles, and parts, ships and boats, and search and navigation equipment.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>4</sup> Estimates of shipments for the semiconductor industry are no longer shown separately. Estimates and percent changes of shipments and inventories for the semiconductor industry are included in computers and electronic products, and all other applicable aggregate totals. Estimates and percent changes for new orders and unfilled orders exclude semiconductor industry data.
