PROPOSAL TO ESTABLISH LEONA VALLEY VITICULTURAL AREA

Washington, D.C. – The Alcohol and Tobacco Tax and Trade Bureau issued a notice of proposed rulemaking in the Federal Register proposing to establish the 13.4 square mile “Leona Valley” viticultural area in the northeast part of Los Angeles County, California. TTB designates viticultural areas to allow vintners to better describe the origin of their wines and allow consumers to better identify wines they may purchase.

Written comments must be received on or before January 22, 2008.
