## Program Descriptions:

**Big Tree Talk** Meet a ranger at the base of the General Grant Tree to learn what it takes to be one of the largest trees on Earth. 15 minutes.

**Cones, Cones, Cones** Who has bigger cones – sugar pines or sequoias? Stop by the Kings Canyon Visitor any time during this informal program for a look at our cone collection, and learn how to identify the unique conifers of California.

**Grant Tree Walk** This easy 1-hour, ½-mile guided walk through the sequoia grove is suitable for all ages and fitness levels. Learn about the giant sequoias and why people have been coming to Grant Grove for more than a century. Meet in the Grant Tree parking lot.

**Ranger in the Grove** How big? How old? What happens in a fire? Look for a ranger along the Grant Tree Trail any time during this informal program to have all your giant sequoia questions answered.
