

**AGENDA
ACMUI MEETING
OCTOBER 5, 2004**

PURPOSE: To provide the Nuclear Regulatory Commission's Advisory Committee on Medical Uses of Isotopes and the Agreement States the opportunity to the working group's recommendations on a possible amendment of the current 10 CFR Part 35, to include adding required hours of didactic training to sections 35.55, 35.190, 35.290, and 35.390 for the alternate pathway.

OUTCOME: The Part 35 working group will gain an understanding of the stakeholder views on the proposed recommendation for consideration in the resolution of comments and preparation of the final rule.

PROCESS: The meeting will proceed as follows:

- 1) Opening Remarks (Presenter: T. Essig, DFO, NRC)
Mr. Essig, Designated Federal Officer, ACMUI, will commence the open session with introductory remarks explaining the purpose of the meeting and welcoming the audience.
- 2) Opening Remarks (Presenter: L. Malmud, Vice-Chairman, ACMUI)
Dr. Malmud will provide ACMUI introductory remarks and identify meeting participants - ACMUI members, Agreement States, and NRC.
- 3) Part 35 Working Group Presentation (Presenter: Dr. R. Broseus, NRC)
Dr. Broseus will present the working group recommendations to the meeting participants.
- 4) ACMUI Discussion
ACMUI members will be provided the opportunity to discuss the recommendation and ask questions of the working group. The ACMUI will not be asked to vote on ACMUI's consensus comments at this time, however, this matter is an agenda item on the October 13-14, 2004 ACMUI meeting.
- 5) Agreement State Discussion
Agreement State representatives, OAS, and CRCPD will be provided the opportunity to discuss the recommendation and ask questions of the working group.

The ACMUI Vice-Chairman will entertain questions or comments from members of the public provided time allows.
