 - (1) Describe the purpose of this DoD information system or electronic collection and briefly describe the types of personal information about individuals collected in the system.

DoDEA uses Chancery SMS to maintain student information including attendance and marks, report cards and transcripts, class schedules, and for generating reports. The data and application resides on secure servers located in the area (USA-DDESS ASC, Peachtree City, GA, Europe- Weisbaden, Germany and Pacific- Okinawa, Japan). School staff members use a secure Internet connection to attach to the servers. Each staff member is given a user id and password and has been provided with a secure role-based access level, which can be customized as necessary.

Approximately 75 % of the locations will utilize Chancery SMS.

The information ranges from student and sponsor demographic information to attendance and grading information.

(2) Briefly describe the privacy risks associated with the PII collected and how these risks are addressed to safeguard privacy.

Records are maintained in a controlled facility. Physical entry is restricted by the use of locks, guards, and is accessible only to authorized personnel. Access to records is limited to person(s) responsible for servicing the record in performance of their official duties and who are properly screened and cleared for need-to-know. Access to computerized data is restricted by passwords, which are changed periodically.
