The Summer Workshop Application (SWA) is an online registration service that was developed for the Department of Defense Education Activity (DoDEA) staff (Teachers, Assistant Principals / Principals, District /Area Liaisons, District / Area Coordinators and HQ Personnel). This application helps the staff members of all levels to register for the educational workshops and for the approving authority to review all submitted registrations.

Categories of records in the system:

Records consist of: first name, last name, Social Security Number (full SSN needed to accurately track for salary), renewal transportation agreement, name of area, name of district, name of school or organization, grade level, subjects taught, years with DoDEA, contact personal e-mail address, contact person, contact phone number. (Added per B. Terzian)

The SWA serves as a system for summer/recess appointment pay.

Archives of who took what course and when.

Within the DoD Component

Used for the issuance of travel TDY orders by the districts and area offices and HQ.

(2) Briefly describe the privacy risks associated with the PII collected and how these risks are addressed to safeguard privacy.

Risk of unauthorized access to and use of the PII collected information.

To address the risk of unauthorized access to and use of the PII collected information, access to the system is password protected and is authenticated thru DoDEA name and password enabled access to the web server.

Privacy Act notification is prompted upon successful login to the system and is likewise evident in the system's various forms and reports (thru headers and/or footers). In addition, appropriate protection is put in place for the handling of SSNs by blacking-out the first seven digits and displaying only the last four digits of the Social Security Number.
