# Issues/Status (20 Jun 12, K-16 Town Hall)



- G** 1. Auto Craft Shop on K-16? **(DFMWR)** Current Army funding will not allow a project of this magnitude at this time.
  
- G** 2. A Smoothie King on K-16? **(AAFES)** Currently we only have 1 Smoothie King in Area II. Smoothie King have requested to open another at the 121 Hosp. Once we go through this process, we will approach them about opening one at K-16.
  
- G** 3. Install a T-Money charge machine at the K-16 CAC? **(DFMWR)** T-Money does not permit unmanned machines outside of their transportation hubs.
  
- G** 4. Why are Contractors being allowed to eat in the DFAC? **(DOL)** Civilians including contractors are not authorized to eat in the DFAC without an Exception to Policy signed by the Garrison Commander. There is no exception to policy in affect.



# Issues/Status (20 Jun 12, K-16 Town Hall)



**G** 5. Can there be a alternate turn-in location for CYS registrations on K-16 or on a website with the checklist? **(DFMWR)** The registration process must be completed in person, web base is not allowed.

**G** 6. Camp Kim, car registration has new requirements. Can new forms be put online and is a checklist available? **(DES)** All forms needed for vehicle registration along with a checklist is posted on the USAG Yongsan web site under DES.

**G** 7. Is there a schedule for movie night? What is the location for viewing? **(DFMWR)** Movie schedule flyers are being distributed and the schedule is also on the marquee. Shown in the CAC movie rm.

**G** 8. Can K-16 get a restaurant? **(DFMWR)** Not in the near future, this will require a new building, financial cost could not be justified. Sunnam Gulf Course is close to K-16 and have a restaurant.

**G** 9. Can someone be designated to clean the new play ground? **(DFMWR)** This issue is being worked by 2/2 AV CSM.

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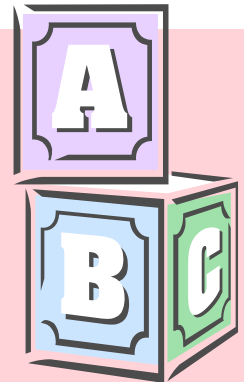

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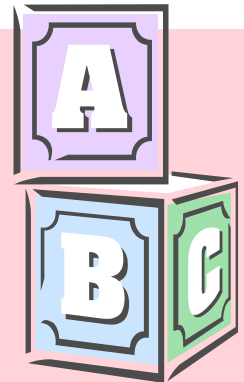
