Background

The DoD Net-Centric Data Strategy provides a key enabler for DoD transformation by establishing the foundation for managing the Department's data in a net-centric environment: ensuring data is visible, accessible, and understandable via community-defined vocabularies and services. The strategy recommends that data management occur within a COI construct since COIs are able to rapidly and effectively solve critical information sharing problems.
