The 2011 Army Emergency Relief (AER) Campaign has ended yielding its highest donation total ever!

The Fort Leavenworth Military Community has once again answered the call. Soldiers, Retirees, Family members, Survivors of the Fallen and Civilian employees have come together to “Help the Army Take Care of its Own.” The campaign, which ran from 1 March through 15 May, met an aggressive goal of \$85,000 and exceeded it, raising over \$96,500. These are funds that will go to AER for future disbursement.

Army Emergency Relief is a private, nonprofit organization founded in 1942 that is dedicated solely to “Helping the Army Take Care of its Own” by providing financial assistance to Soldiers and their Families in time of financial need. The program offers grants and interest free-loans to Active duty and Retired Soldiers, activated Reservists Retirees, Survivors and their eligible Family members.
