Change Order # 5: In accordance with FAR 52.243-2, Changes – Cost Reimbursement, the contractor is directed to provide the Super High Efficiency Neutron Counter (SuperHENC) unit located at the Waste Receiving and Processing Building (WRAP) for loan to the National TRU Program, managed by the Carlsbad Field Office (CBFO). In accordance with the referenced clause, if the Contractor requests an adjustment, it is the government's intention to begin negotiation within 90 days, and definitize this change by supplemental agreement within 150 days.

The contractor's costs associated with the activities necessary to loan of the SuperHENC, in accordance with the work description provided on page 2, will be allocable to an inter-entity work order (IEWO) provided by CBFO. Funds to be expended for this activity shall be in accordance with the fully-executed request for services.

Except as provided herein, all terms and conditions of the document referenced in Item 9A or 10A, as heretofore changed, remains unchanged and in full force and effect.

Work Description:

The Contractor is directed to provide the Super High Efficiency Neutron Counter (SuperHENC) unit located at the Waste Receiving and Processing Building (WRAP) for loan to the National TRU Program, managed by the Carlsbad Field Office (CBFO). The Contractor shall prepare the unit ready for shipment in an over-the-road shipping configuration and stage the unit for pick up at its current location. This includes but is not limited to disconnecting utilities and appurtenances, positioning all counting devices in an over-the-road shipping configuration, sanitizing all computer systems and removing WRAP-supplied office equipment, and verifying the device's road worthiness. The Contractor shall also re-package the Californium calibration source into the original shipping container. Shipment of the source and transportation of the SuperHENC unit, once staged, will be accomplished by the CBFO.
