C.2.7.2 KE Basin Demolition

General Scope:

The Contractor shall complete demolition and disposal activities of the K East basin.

Detailed Scope and Requirements:

The Contractor shall:

- •Deactivate K East basin systems and isolate from 105 K East Reactor,
- •Remove/drain K East basin water and transport to 200 ETF for treatment,
- •Remove above-grade K East basin superstructure and transport to ERDF for disposal,
- Demolish the K East basin and transport to ERDF for disposal; and
- Stabilize soil beneath the basin for subsequent remediation.

C.2.7.3 K Basins Sludge Treatment System

General Scope:

The Contractor shall <u>utilize existing</u> design, <u>and procurement packages to procure</u>, construct, and <u>perform</u> acceptance testing <u>of</u> the K Basins Sludge Treatment System.

Detailed Scope and Requirements:

The Contractor shall:

- Conduct alternatives analysis for the sludge disposition;
- Complete sludge treatment and approved storage design;
- Complete sludge treatment system <u>and post-packaging components</u> procurements;
- •Complete modifications to the Cold Vacuum Drying Facility (CVDF);
- Complete construction of the Sludge Treatment System and associated facilities;
 and
- Obtain Critical Decisions-4, Approve Start of Operations or Project Closeout approval as defined in DOE O 413.3A.

C.2.7.4 K Basins Sludge Treatment

General Scope:

The Contractor shall operate the Sludge Treatment System to treat and package the sludge material (approximately 50-29 m³) into a waste form that is suitable for approved off-site disposal. Treated sludge shall be transported to an approved on-site storage location.

Detailed Scope and Requirements:

The Contractor shall treat K Basins sludge in accordance with the documented safety analysis, Defense Nuclear Facilities Safety Board (DNFSB) Recommendation 2000-1 Implementation Plan, *An Implementation Plan for Stabilization and Storage of Nuclear Material*, Washington State-approved permits, the TPA, and related-CERCLA documents.

The Contractor shall treat and package the knock-out pot sludge waste stream separately from the remaining sludge waste streams.

The Contractor shall transport the treated sludge to an approved on-site storage location.
