The Troop Visit will also feature a number of entertainers who will perform at each stop during the trip to include Reggie McFadden (comedian); Diana DeGarmo (pop vocalist, runner-up in American Idol); Michael Peterson (Country-Western musician); and COL Jack Jacobs, USA (Ret) - Medal of Honor recipient (and military analyst with NBC.) The "show" is a roughly 30-40 minute thank you to the troops beginning with remarks from General Pace followed by the celebrities, after which they'll spend about 60 minutes interacting with the troops, signing autographs, and posing for photos.

I spoke with OSD/PA and it looks like the SecDef/VCJCS press briefing tomorrow will most likely be around 1330-1400, so they would like to schedule the Mil Analyst call following that. **Can you please let me know Lt Gen Sharp's availability for a 30-minute call late tomorrow afternoon, perhaps at 1600?** That will allow us time to gather the information from the briefing and what SecDef and VCJCS said to prep Lt Gen Sharp.

Also, I clearly passed the message that both a Hill briefing and a press briefing on Thursday would be quite difficult to accomplish. OSD/LA is working the issue of the Hill briefing and whether that will happen or not... or if the report will just be delivered to the staffers. When there is some indication as to what will happen with that piece, there will be further discussion on the press conference. More to follow sirs...

Mr Di Rita said he would call Lt Gen Sharp to discuss.



--OSD PA coordinates weekly conference calls, and quarterly meetings here in the Pentagon with a group of retired senior military and civilian defense experts who serve as "talking heads" or analysts for various media outlets. The purpose is to provide accurate information with the appropriate context to assist them in their duties as analysts. The Chairman has been involved in several of these in the past.
