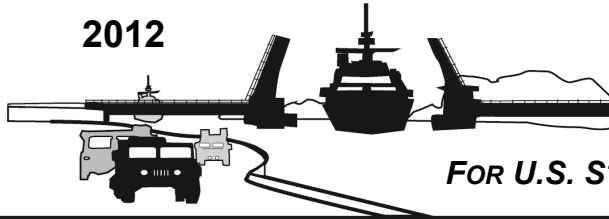

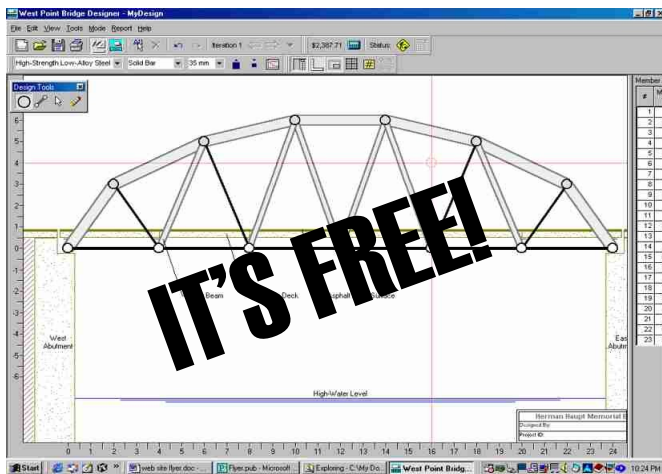


# The Army-Navy Bridge Design Contest
