SUBJECT: Revision to Notice PIH 97-60 (HA), dated December 4, 1997; Responsibility for Completion of the Form HUD-50058, Family Report

On October 26, 1996, the Native American Housing Assistance and Self-Determination Act of 1996 (NAHASDA) was signed into law. NAHASDA repealed provisions relating to Indian housing assistance under the 1937 Act. On December 4, 1997, Notice PIH 97-60 was issued which indicated that IHAs are required to submit form HUD 50058, Family Report, for all programs.

This guidance is to clarify that Indian housing authorities (IHAs), Indian tribes, or tribally designated housing entities (TDHEs) are not required to complete HUD-50058 and transmit data into the Multifamily Tenant Characteristics System (MTCS) for the rental, turnkey or Mutual Help programs. However, the requirement exists to follow Notice PIH 97-60 for the Section 8 assisted housing programs until such time the Annual Contribution Contract (ACC) expires.
