Follow N Tower Road in a southerly direction, along Dyson Creek Road, proceeding in a northerly direction at Mary Barron Road, proceeding in a southerly direction at Highway 165 and SR 524 which meets Abe Hall Road proceeding in a southerly direction, moving along the Southern Rail Road until it meets Allen Road traveling in an easterly direction until it meets Highway 8. Follow Highway 8 in a northerly direction to the border of Grant and LaSalle Parishes at Little River. Follow the parish boundary line (Little River) in a southerly direction until it meets the point where the borders of Grant, LaSalle and Rapides Parishes meet. Proceed in a southwesterly direction following the border between Grant and Rapides Parishes to a point where an imaginary line connects the border with Flagan Bayou. Follow Flagan Bayou along a southerly direction until it meets an imaginary line that meanders in a southern then eastern direction until it reaches Esler Field Road. Follow the boundary between Natchitoches and Rapides parishes in a northeasterly direction until it reaches the intersection of Rapides, Natchitoches and Grant parishes. Proceeding in a southerly direction between Grant and Rapides along the Red River to the point where the parish line intersects with an imaginary line that connects with Highway 1. Travel Highway 1to Highway 121 and following Highway 121 in southerly direction until it meets Highway 1200. Travel Highway 1200 in a southerly direction to St. Clair Road which turns into Brown Creek Road proceeding in a southerly

Follow Brown Creek Road to the point where it meets R Goleman Road {FR 272} continuing in a southerly direction to Highway 488 (Twin Bridges Road) as it meets Boyd Road, to Nesmith Road, proceeding east along Sugartown Road.
