Patient Movement Items Tracking System (PMITS)

The PMITS is a Department of Defense Military Health System application that electronically tracks medical equipment used during aeromedical evacuations [AE]. PMITS tracks the biomedical equipment needed and used to support critical patient life sustainment and monitoring during AE missions. PMITS is used by the Army, Air Force and Navy during peacetime, contingency and wartime operations.
