## **Patient Movement Items Tracking System (PMITS) Web v2.0** <https://pmits.csd.disa.mil/>

The PMITS website delivers worldwide total asset visibility. Collecting its data from Patient Movement Items (PMI) scanning locations, the PMITS website acts as the central repository for all PMI equipment tracking information. It is a powerful resource that enables users to view and manage portable medical assets being distributed across multiple sites during patient air evacuation missions. One of the key features of the PMITS website is the flexibility in how customers can search PMI inventories and tracking history. Through secure and easy access to the web, PMITS users at all levels can conveniently access, search and report on PMI equipment data anyplace, anywhere, anytime.

### **Background**

PMITS is a Department of Defense Military Health System application that electronically tracks medical equipment used during aeromedical evacuations. PMITS tracks the biomedical equipment needed and used to support critical patient life sustainment and monitoring during AE missions. PMITS is used by the Department of Defense during peacetime, contingency and wartime operations.
