Introduction/Background

- □ Letter to DOT Secretary Slater 2-16-00
 - From NTSB, AAA, ATS, IIHS, NSC, NAGHSR
 - 35 Belted/25 Unbelted Testing 208
 - Return 30 Unbelted Requirement Based on Real-World Evidence
 - NHTSA to expedite data collection; auto manufacturers to commit additional funding
 - Evaluation of Data by Panel of Experts

Introduction/Background (Cont'd)

- Alliance Letter to White House Chief of Staff 3-9-00
 - Commits to Major Real-World Data Gathering Program
 - Proposes Doubling 300 SCI Cases Proposed for Investigation in NHTSA 2001 Budget
 - Continued Commitment to Increase Seat Belt Use

Introduction/Background (Cont'd)

- □ Alliance Letter to OMB (4-5-00)
 - Committed to 3-Year Program of 300 SCI Cases Per Year
 - Program to be Managed by Independent Third Party
 - Oversight Provided by Blue Ribbon Panel
 - Transparent Process
 - Data Collected is Available to All
 - Consistency with TEA-21 Directives

Contract for Independent Look at Field Data Collection

- 8 Options for Additional Crash Data Explored
- Discussion of Important Questions to Answer; How Much Data Needed
- Recommendation to Wring More Cases
 Out of NASS CDS
- Recommendation to Expand NASS

- NHTSA and Auto Industry Observers
- Two meetings of Full Panel (2-26-01 and 7-11-01)

Blue Ribbon Panel Consensus Issues to Date

- Use the NASS Framework for Case Notification and Selection
- Occupants of Interest All Front Seat-Restrained and Unrestrained
- Vehicles of Interest-All Passenger
 Vehicles-Current Model Year and Prior 4
- Frontal Crashes Only-All Severity Levels-Stratified to Over-Sample More Severe

Blue Ribbon Panel Consensus Issues to Date (Cont'd)

- Probability Based Sampling
- Nationally Representative Data
- Set Aside Funds for Analysis and Evaluation
- Host Public Meetings Every 6 Months After Data Available
- □ Set Up Web Site
- Respond to NHTSA Federal Register Notice

Timing/Logistics

- 3 Years Data Collection, 6 Month Ramp-Up and Wind-Down
- NHTSA Estimates 1800 Cases Over Period
- Alliance to Negotiate MOU With NHTSA
- Alliance to Contract With 2 NASS Zone
 Centers and Volpe-August 2001
