

COMMAND MASTER CHIEF PETTY OFFICER HARRY MARINO, U.S. NAVY
NAVY SENIOR ENLISTED ADVISOR, JOINT RESERVE FORCE (J9)
HEADQUARTERS, DEFENSE LOGISTICS AGENCY

Master Chief Marino enlisted in June 1983, and attended Storekeeper “A” School at Naval Technical Training Center, Meridian, Mississippi. His first set of orders took him to Service School Command at Great Lakes, Illinois as a requisitioning storekeeper. In March 1985, he was transferred to the USS MAHAN (DDG-42), and served as S-1’s Leading Petty Officer. During this tour, he deployed to the Mediterranean and the Gulf of Libya.

In June 1987, he left active duty and joined the Navy Reserves. He served as the Training LPO for NR AOR-6 Kalamazoo, Warehouse Supervisor for NR ABFC SSU (SM), Unit LPO for USS PAUL (FF-1080), LPO and Asst. Training Officer for NR PERSMOBTM 402, Operations LPO for FISC East 104, Command LPO for NR NAVICP PHILA TEAM TWO, and Senior Enlisted Advisor for NR FISC NFK 407.



In June 2001, Master Chief Marino reported to Navy Cargo Handling Battalion (NCHB) TEN. His leadership roles included: Assistant Company Commander, Assistant Training Officer, Operations SCPO and Senior Enlisted Advisor. In October 2005, he joined Navy Air Cargo Handling Battalion (NACHB) ONE and served as the Command Senior Chief.

In February 2007, he deployed to Al Asad, Iraq with NAVELSG FWD MACH Team VII as the Senior Enlisted Leader. After deployment, he served at the 2nd Navy Expeditionary Logistics Regiment (NELR) as the SCPO in 2008; NCHB 4 from 2009 to 2010; NCHB 8 and 2nd NELR as Command Master Chief.

In March 2012 CMDCM Marino was requested to join the USFF staff as the Commemorations of the War of 1812 Senior Enlisted Leader. Most recently, Master Chief Marino joined Joint Reserve Force, Defense Logistics Agency HQ at Fort Belvoir, VA as the Senior Enlisted Leader.

Master Chief Marino has an MBA from Ashford University and been employed in various senior healthcare management roles including: Chief Financial Officer, Executive Director and Chief Executive Officer. He is currently a Healthcare Management Consultant and serves on various professional boards and volunteers his time with youths in this community.

CMDCM Marino is Expeditionary Warfare and Fleet Marine Force qualified and his awards include the Navy Commendation Medal (four awards), Navy Achievement Medal (three awards), Navy Good Conduct Medal, Naval Reserve Meritorious Service Medal (seven awards), and various unit, campaign and other personal awards.
