

“From-To” Example

This table illustrates how work processes will change for each given role by implementing a new intervention. This type of table can be helpful when considering the effects of a particular intervention. It may also be used to communicate the before and after work processes of the end-users.

Example Target: VTE Prophylaxis

Workflow Step	Before (From)	After (To)
Nurse: Admission Assessment	Entering vitals into Nursing Documentation	All vitals must be captured in the EHR in appropriate fields or the clinical logic and assessment in CDS will not work correctly
Physician: H&P, Plan	Use paper order set	Electronic Order set with assessment tool drawing clinical data from EHR
Physician: Admission Order	Enter medication into CPOE	Enter medication in CPOE, new rule suggests mechanoprophylaxis when more appropriate or there is a possible ADE for Warfarin.
Pharmacy: Medication Verification	Check medication order, suggested mechanoprophylaxis	Double check final medication suggestion.
Nurse: Treatment Administration	Administer chemo or mechanical prophylaxis	No change.
Nurse: Care Plan/Education	Educate the patient on appropriate practices for preventing VTE	No change.
Nurse: Discharge	EHR generated end of visit summary	No change
