April 1 Update

The satellite telemetry buoy attached to line trailing the whale continues to function. The data indicate the whale is still swimming, and generally moving northward. NOAA has suspended atsea missions to the whale for the time being. The emergency response team is regrouping and considering if, when, where, and how a new mission can be mounted.
