Sandra Lahi	Patch 4 was released 12/12/03. AZ AHCCCS certified 3P Patch 4 and sites who will be submitting to AHCCCS will have to install Patch 4. ITSC requested that when rollout plan is defined for Phoenix and Navajo Area that a copy be submitted to ITSC for planning. With the patch certified, a question surfaced, do the sites now send test data files or live

	files from real claims? Clarification is being sought.
	If any sites are interested in testing with other Insurers, contact Sandra or Adrian.
	If you have tribal sites billing to UGS Medicare FI, UGS has instructions on how to begin testing with them.
	Focus continues to be supporting the testing Medicaid plans for NM, CO, SD, ND, OR, WI, and MS.
	835 A/R, p4, v1.7and AHCCCS Supplemental File
	Still testing AR Patch 4. It currently has been tested for the Trailblazers Part A, 835 format. The AR Standard Adjustment and Reason Codes have also been revised by replacing the pending categories to the Nonpayment categories. AR Patch 4 did not include the PNC bank testing module as there was a delay in getting the PNC bank side of things setup. Part A Medicare tested at Tuba City, Sells and Kayenta.
Charolett Melcher	For Part A, we're testing sites importing from PNC?
Sandra Lahi	Not at this time. A conference call is scheduled with PNC this afternoon to review status.
	AHCCCs supplemental file: Linda Lehman is looking at AZ AHCCCS supplemental file. AHCCCS has their own table and ITSC is trying to work with them on it. AHCCCS has also come out with an 824 format which is the error report for existing 837 testing. This only started a few weeks ago. A one-on-one meeting is scheduled with AHCCCS next week to discuss the issues.
