AGENDA ITEMS ADDRESSED

<u>Items of follow up from ITSC Business Transactions Training held in February 2004 – UPDATE STATUS REPORTS.</u>

<u>Item # 1 - 997/824 Error Report software design – Sandra Lahi</u>

ITSC will meet with the developer on June 14th in Albuquerque to review final draft and to establish procedures. It is designed to capture site information in anticipation of reporting to be used in the future. An announcement will be made when it is ready for usage.

Item # 2 -- National Training Online Modules – First phase –Sandra Lahi/Kurt Priessman

This project is in phase II portion. Need to get more people involved for input on the development. There will be a NBOC meeting at the end of June to discuss the project. The plan for this project is to combine the best practice processes and information between facilities so as not to duplicate so much work related to testing. If you are interested in seeing this draft document, please contact Sandra or Kurt and send your feedback to them.

<u>Item # 4 -- Indian Health Service CMS representation – Issues received/Conference call to be</u> scheduled – Elmer Brewster

Have issues document ready to present to CMS. Elmer advised that it should also include recommendations for ideal resolutions. Sandra and Kurt will work on that, will have ready within a day, and will be able to set up a call.

Reports from Area Office Leads/ITSC – (1) Is there progress with testing the HIPAA transactions for your area? (2) What issues are you running into? 3) If there are issues, are these due to RPMS software?

Aberdeen Joan reported that testing continues with Medicare for Rapid City, believes

they will not meet the July deadline for 837 compliancy. ND Medicaid testing, in production status. Notified site managers to give Linda access so

local mods can be sent. They will be testing SD Medicaid soon.

Alaska Lue Rae reported there will be a HIPAA task force meeting to focus on

security issues. Has programmer working with site on testing, does not know which payer they are testing with. Sandra reports that Manillaq is working with the state to become HIPAA compliant for the 837. Will hopefully be

set up by the end of the month.

Albuquerque Gail reports that most sites are sending Medicare and Medicaid files. They

are having problems with the occurrence codes for the 837I, should be a two digit code. Made contact with all Salud's for testing status. Cimarron is able to send an 835, but wants to use the AMPMED clearinghouse for the 837. Gail will contact AMPMED. She will also be providing another HIPAA

training session Monday the 14th.

Bemidji Margo states that they had a successful 837 file to Medicaid on the 8th, and

the site is checking on errors, since the files did reject. They have installed the test patch 5 and retested. File submitted fine, but did receive other errors. On the 835 PNC project, site did test a good file and Margo will check with Jan to finish up the posting. Red Lake will test one more file then will move

to production status.

Navajo Brenda reports 8 units testing. Five are in production with Medicare and

Medicaid. Only three are in full production. Lack of response from AHCCCS is delaying testing. Name and DOB are missing from claims. Testing patch 5- problem with POS not showing on claims. 837 and NSF files both failed

due to POS changing from 21 to 22. Quovadx testing with Gallup,

connection reestablished. Daisy Barney is assisting sites, and designated one user per site as contact. Payer listing from Quovadx to be issued tomorrow.

Portland David reported that he is working to get sites to continue testing with TB part

> B. Shonda has sent fix for the 2310D loop for Medicare Part B, still waiting to verify fix with the payer. Billing Idaho, Oregon, and Washington and having user problems, not software issues. Still having issues with SBR segment of 837P files. He is looking into using the sequencing from Patient Registration, but not sure if it will work. He has tried to use the error report software and had problems. Sandra questioned whether Warm Springs had installed and is testing patch 5, David did not know, but did not want them to test. Sandra will contact Gwen Steelman to verify if the patch was installed.

Phoenix Charolett reported that they are currently testing 5 out of 7 sites for

AHCCCS. They did confirm with Lori Petri that certain claim types will be passing. For Medicare, Glen is working with Claims net as a clearinghouse. Elko submitted 837 to First Health and to Medicare yesterday. They are working with PNC Bank to create a single transmission point, like Tucson Area. Each site will need to install an FTP client in order to download their RA's for the 835. Parker is still testing Medicare Part B, and San Carlos will

be next.

completed.
