 - o 16 states reporting in 2009, with 95% of data submitted from California
- **Baseline measurement:** 92% adherence

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Metric Definitions

Adherence to the CLIP bundle within NHSN requires that all four of the following are true:

- <u>Hand hygiene</u> Inserter performed hand cleansing with either soap and water or an alcohol-based hand rub product prior to central line insertion
- <u>Appropriate skin preparation</u> Dependent on the patient's age the following agent(s) was used to disinfect the insertion site:
 - o For patients ≥ 2 months of age: Chlorhexidene gluconate (CHG)
 - For patients < 2 months of age: One or more of the following:
 - Povidone iodine
 - Alcohol
 - CHG
 - Other antiseptic documented by the recorder
- Skin preparation agent was allowed to dry before central line insertion
- Maximal sterile barriers All five of the following were used during the insertion
 - Sterile gloves (worn by the inserter)
 - o Sterile gown (worn by the inserter)
 - Cap (worn by inserter)
 - Mask (worn by inserter)
 - Large sterile drape (placed over patient)
