## CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

## U.S. SECURITIES AND EXCHANGE COMMISSION

---

### COMPLAINT NAMES ROYALPAR INDUSTRIES, INC.

The Commission announced that on July 31, 1981, it filed a civil injunctive action in the U.S. District Court for the District of Columbia against Royalpar Industries, Inc. (RPI) with principal offices in West Hartford, Connecticut. RPI, through a subsidiary, Ewing Technical Design, Inc., furnishes engineers or other experienced technical personnel to firms in the aerospace, electronics, engineering and related industries. The Commission alleges violations of the reporting provisions of the securities laws and seeks a Judgment of Permanent Injunction and other relief.

The Commission alleges that RPI, as part of a continuing course of violative conduct extending over several years, has failed to file its Annual Report on Form 10-K for its fiscal year ended January 31, 1981, and its Quarterly Report for its fiscal quarter ended April 30, 1981, required to have been filed with the Commission by May 1, and June 14, 1981, respectively. Its complaint sets forth repeated failures by RPI to file timely Annual and Quarterly Reports over several years. The Commission requests that the Court order RPI to file its delinquent Annual and Quarterly Reports forthwith. It also requests that the Court enjoin RPI from further violation of the reporting provisions of the securities laws. (SEC v. Royalpar Industries, Inc., D.C.D.C., Civil Action No. 81-1802). ## HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

### MIDDLE SOUTH ENERGY, INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until August 24 to request a hearing on a proposal by Middle South Energy, Inc. (MSE), a special purpose subsidiary of Middle South Utilities, Inc., a registered holding company, whereby MSE proposes to enter into a bank loan agreement with a group of foreign lenders in the maximum aggregate principal amount of \$300 million. MSE has been granted an exception from the competitive bidding requirements of Rule 50 so that it may retain a financial advisor to explore the market for such arrangement and negotiate a loan agreement with lenders. ### NEW ENGLAND ELECTRIC SYSTEM

An order has been issued approving a proposal by New England Electric System (NEES), a registered holding company, and New England Energy, Inc. (NEEI), a fuel procurement subsidiary of NEES, whereby a joint venture in which NEEI is a 51 percent participant will enter into a credit agreement to provide up to \$20 million in construction financing for the building of a collier. The obligations of the joint venture will be guaranteed by NEES. (Rel. 35-22146 - August 3)

## SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

### NOTICES OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Philadelphia Stock Exchange has filed the following proposed rule changes under Rule 19b-4: (1) (SR-Phlx-81-10) to amend its short sale rule; and (2) (SR-Phlx-81-11) to provide that a Registered Options Trader (ROT), when initiating an opening transaction from on the trading floor, will be required to yield priority and parity to all off-floor orders, even if the ROT places his on-floor order on the specialist's book. Publication of the proposals are expected to be made in the Federal Register during the week of August 3. (Rel. 34-17990 and 34-17991)

## APPROVAL OF AMENDED PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission has approved an amended proposed rule change filed by the Municipal Securities Rulemaking Board (SR-MSRB-81-6) to revise the procedures used by municipal securities dealers wishing to closeout purchased transactions which have not yet been completed. The changes will become effective September 14, 1981. (Rel. 34-17994)
