ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

MAURICE ARESTY AND LOUIS VARDABASH BARRED

The Commission announced that in a public administrative proceeding, Maurice Aresty and Louis Vardabash, formerly registered representatives employed by a broker-dealer registered with the Commission, submitted Offers of Settlement which the Commission accepted.

Without admitting or denying the findings, Aresty and Vardabash consented to an Order Making Findings & Imposing Remedial sanctions which finds that they wilfully violated the antifraud provisions through fraudulent selling practices that included: profit guarantees, price predictions without a reasonable basis, executing unauthorized purchases, and refusing to execute sell orders, for Aresty; and unauthorized purchaes and price predictions without a reasonable basis, for Vardabash.

The Commission barred Aresty and Vardabash from association in the securities industry provided that after two years and 18 months, respectively, from the date of the Order, they may apply to become associated with such entities by application to the appropriate self-regulatory organizations or, where there is no appropriate self-regulatory organization, to the Commission. (Rel. 34-23918)

CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

BEALL, GEIRINGER AND SHANLEY ORDERED TO FILE TIMELY FORMS 3 AND 4

The Commission announced that on January 5 and 6 the U.S. District Court for the District of Columbia entered Final Orders against Samuel E. Beall, III, Stefan L. Geiringer, and John F. Shanley, ordering them in the future to file timely Form 3 Initial Statements of Beneficial Ownership of Securities and Form 4 Statements of Changes in Beneficial Ownership of Securities, as required by Section 16(a) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, Rule 16a-1, and Forms 3 and 4. The Final Orders were entered in three separate and unrelated civil actions filed by the Commission on January 5. Simultaneously, the defendants, without admitting or denying the allegations in the Complaints, consented to the Final Orders.

These cases are a product of the Commission's ongoing monitoring of the filing of Forms 3 and 4. The Commission and its staff will continue to provide guidance to persons who are unfamiliar with the filing requirements. (Attention is directed to Interpretive Release on Rules Applicable to Insider Reporting and Trading, Rel. 34-18114, October 1, 1981). However, those who fail to file such statements or to make such filings in a timely manner may find themselves the subject of appropriate enforcement proceedings. (SEC v. Samuel E. Beall, III, USDC DC, Civil Action No. 87-0017; SEC v. Stefan L. Geiringer, USDC DC, Civil Action No. 87-0018; and SEC v. John F. Shanley, USDC DC, Civil Action No. 87-0019). (LR-11326)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

MONARCH LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY

An order has been issued granting Monarch Life Insurance Company (Monarch), Variable Account Al of Monarch, Variable Account Bl of Monarch, The Fidelity Variable Account of Monarch, and Monarch Resources, Inc. (Applicants) exemptions from Sections 2(a) (32), 2(a)(35), 22(c), 26(a)(2), 27(a)(1), 27(c)(1), 27(c)(2), 27(d) and 27(f) of the Investment Company Act and Rules 6e-2 and 22c-1. In connection with certain single premium life insurance contracts to be issued through the three variable accounts,

the order permits: (1) the deduction of a contingent deferred sales load; (2) deductions from each contract's investment base for various insurance-related charges; (3) deductions from the variable account's assets for minimum death benefit risk charges; and (4) partial withdrawal rights that affect the duration of a contract's minimum death benefit guarantee. (Rel. IC-15503 -Dec. 29, 1986)

DREXEL BURNHAM LAMBERT MORTGAGE ACCEPTANCE CORP.

An order has been issued exempting Drexel Burnham Lambert Mortgage Acceptance Corp. and certain trusts to be created by it from all provisions of the Act in connection with the issuance and sale of mortgage-related securities and ownership interests in the trusts. (Rel. IC-15504 - Dec. 29, 1986)

EQUUS INVESTMENTS I, L.P.
