EXCHANGE COMMISSION

REGISTRATION STATEMENT OF QUANTUM FINANCIAL SERVICES, INC. SUSPENDED

The Commission issued an Order Instituting Stop Order Proceedings with respect to a registration statement filed by Quantum Financial Services, Inc., of Salt Lake City, Utah, in connection with a planned public offering of its common stock. In the Order, the Commission found that the registration statement included untrue statements of material facts and omitted to state material facts required to be stated therein or necessary to make the statements therein not misleading with respect to, among other things, Quantum's assets, financial statements, business plan, planned use of proceeds, plan of distribution of the stock, and that Quantum failed to cooperate in and obstructed an examination by the Commission's staff. The Commission suspended the registration statement from becoming effective. Quantum consented to the Order without admitting or denying the findings made therein. (Rel. 33-6686)

MARVIN D. HANEY SANCTIONED

The Commission issued an order instituting administrative proceedings and imposing remedial sanctions under Rule 2(e) of the Rules of Practice against Marvin D. Haney, a certified public accountant. The order noted that Haney had been permanently enjoined from violating antifraud provisions of the Securities Act of 1933 and Securities Exchange Act of 1934 by the U.S District Court for the District of Columbia in an action filed by the Commission. The Commission alleged in that action that Haney violated these provisions in connection with the preparation and an audit of financial statements of G.C. Technologies, Inc. and that he engaged in additional violative conduct involving two other companies, Quantum Financial Services, Inc. and ProTech Accounting Corporation, while serving as an officer of those companies. In the order, the Commission suspended Haney from appearing or practicing before the Commission, except that after three years he may apply to resume appearing and practicing upon meeting certain requirements set forth in the order. Haney consented to the issuance of the order without admitting or denying the facts or findings therein. (Rel. 33-6687; AAER-126)

CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

MARVIN D. HANEY, D. NEAL MARLETT ENJOINED

The U.S. District Court for the District of Columbia entered final judgments permanently enjoining Marvin D. Haney, a certified public accountant, and D. Neal Marlett, a businessman, from violating antifraud provisions of the Securities Act of 1933 and Securities Exchange Act of 1934 in an action previously instituted by the Commission against Balanced Financial Management Inc. and eight other defendants in October 1986. In its complaint, the Commission alleged that Marlett and Haney violated the antifraud provisions while serving as officers of Quantum Financial Services, Inc., of Salt Lake City, Utah, and that Haney committed additional violations while serving as an officer of ProTech Accounting Corporation, formerly known as Managed Accounting Services, Inc., also of Salt Lake City, and in connection with an audit of the financial statements of G.C. Technologies, Inc., of Sparks, Nevada. The two defendants consented to the final judgments without admitting or denying the allegations in the Commission's complaint. (SEC v. Balanced Financial Management, Inc., et al., USDC DC, Civil Action No. 86-2818). (LR-11341)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

AMENDMENT OF PRIOR COMMISSION ORDERS

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until February 17 to request a hearing on an SEC proposal to amend 50 orders previously issued under the Investment Company Act. These orders approved exchange transactions between open-end investment companies that imposed fees on the exchanges. The proposed amendment would require the companies holding the orders to conform their exchange transactions to proposed Rule 11a-3 [Rel. IC-15494], when adopted. (Rel. IC-15546 - Jan. 20)

WICKLOW 1986 FUND

An order has been issued granting Wicklow 1986 Fund certain exemptions and confidential treatment for certain reports for a series of employees' securities companies. (Rel. IC-15547 - Jan. 20)

MORGAN STANLEY GROUP INC.

An order has been issued on an application of Morgan Stanley Group Inc. and its subsidiary, Morgan Stanley Capital I, Inc., permitting the subsidiary and certain trusts that it has formed or may form to issue mortgage-backed securities and sell beneficial ownership interest in such trusts. METROPOLITAN LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY

An order has been issued to Metropolitan Life Insurance Company, et al., exempting, to the extent necessary, the proposed reorganization of several separate accounts of Metropolitan Life Insurance Company into Separate Account E of Metropolitan, a unit investment trust, and the issuance of shares of an underlying open-end management investment company in exchange for the assets of the several separate accounts. (Rel. IC-15549 - Jan. 20)

DELISTING GRANTED

An order has been issued granting the application of the American Stock Exchange to strike all put and call option contracts respecting the common stock of THRIFTY CORPORATION from listing and registration thereon. (Rel. 34-24012)

Notices have been issued giving interested persons until February 9 and February 10, respectively, to comment on the application of the following stock exchanges for unlisted trading privileges in specified number of issues which are listed and registered on one or more other national securities exchanges and are reported in the consolidated transaction reporting system: Cincinnati Stock Exchange - 25 issues. SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved, on an accelerated basis, a proposed rule change filed by The National Association of Securities Dealers (SR-NASD-87-2) updating the Trade Acceptance and Reconciliation Service (TARS) to extend the features of TARS to OTC transactions in municipal bonds. (Rel. 34-24022)

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed by the Options Clearing Corporation (SR-OCC-86-11) amending Article VI, Section 11 of its By-Laws to clarify the standards and procedures for adjusting option contracts in conformance with changes to their underlying securities. (Rel. 34-24024)

TRUST INDENTURE ACT RELEASES

SOUTHWEST FINANCIAL CORPORATION

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until February 17 to request a hearing on an application by the Southwest Financial Corporation, an Arizona corporation, under Section 310(b)(1)(ii) of the Trust Indenture Act of 1939. The application declares that the trusteeship of The Valley National Bank of Arizona under an indenture and supplements thereto is not so likely to involve a material conflict of interest as to make it necessary in the public interest or for the protection of investors to disqualify the Bank from acting as trustee under the indenture and indenture supplements. The indenture is dated August 1, 1984 and the securities outstanding under the indenture and indenture supplements are various issues of mortgage-collateralized bonds. (Rel. TI-2062)

ACQUISITIONS OF SECURITIES

Companies and individuals must report to the Commission within ten days on Schedule 13D if after the acquisition of equity securities of a public company their beneficial interest therein exceeds five percent. Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
