ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

STATON INVESTMENTS, INC. AND WILLIAM F. STATON SANCTIONED

The Commission instituted public administrative proceedings against Staton Investments, Inc. and William F. Staton under Sections 203(e) and (f) of the Investment Advisers Act of 1940. Simultaneously, Staton Investments and Staton submitted offers of settlement for the purpose of disposing of the issues raised in the administrative action.

In accepting the offers of settlement, the Commission found that Staton Investments had wilfully violated, and Staton had aided and abetted violations of, the books and records provisions of the Advisers Act and rules thereunder. Based on these findings, the Commission ordered that Staton Investments' registration as an investment adviser be revoked and that Staton be barred from association with any investment adviser. (Rel. IA-1053)

SANCTIONS IMPOSED UPON R. A. JOHNSON AND COMPANY, INC.

The Commission instituted public administrative proceedings under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 against R. A. Johnson and Company, Inc., formerly known as R. L. Smith and Associates, Inc., a Salt Lake City brokerage firm, and simultaneously accepted the firm's Offer of Settlement. In that Offer, the firm consented to the Commission's Order Instituting Proceedings, Making Findings and Imposing Remedial Sanctions, without admitting or denying the allegations contained therein.

Accordingly, the Commission has entered an Order finding that the firm, while doing business as R. L. Smith and Associates, wilfully violated the registration, antifraud and antimanipulative provisions in the offer and sale of the securities of Gay International, Inc., a San Francisco-based corporation. The Order also finds that the firm was enjoined from violation of those provisions in SEC v. Gay International, Inc., Civ. No. C-84-5997 MHP [see LR-11281]. Further, in its Order the Commission censured the firm and ordered that it adopt certain compliance procedures proposed in its Offer. (Rel. 34-23985)

CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

RECEIVER APPOINTED IN ACTION AGAINST PHILIP C. CORDEK AND BAKER & GETTY DIVERSIFIED, INC.

The Chicago Regional Office announced that on January 20 District Court Judge George W. White, Northern District of Ohio, appointed a Receiver to marshal and conserve all assets of Philip C. Cordek and Baker & Getty Diversified, Inc. The Receiver, Don Graves of Cleveland, Ohio, will also make reports to the Court regarding the existence and location of the defendants' assets and a final report regarding how funds should be distributed.

Judge White had previously entered a Temporary Restraining Order against the defendants on December 9, 1986. Subsequently, the defendants consented to Orders of Preliminary Injunction on December 15, 1986. The Commission's December 9, 1986 complaint alleges that the defendants violated the antifraud provisions of the securities laws in the offer and sale of securities in the form of common stock to approximately 20 investors, thereby raising at least \$2 million from approximately December 1985 to the present. The complaint further alleges that the defendants sold the securities by making untrue statements of material facts concerning, among other things, the use of investor proceeds, and that the defendants would effect the purchases of common stock for which investors had paid, when, in fact, no transactions in securities were effected. (SEC v. Philip C. Cordek and Baker & Getty Diversified, NDOH, No. C-86-5126, filed December 9, 1986). (LR-11342)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

AMERICAN INTERNATIONAL LIFE ASSURANCE COMPANY OF NEW YORK

An order has been issued granting American International Life Assurance Company of New York, AIG Variable Account A, and American International Fund Distributors, Inc. exemptions from Sections 26(a) and 27(c)(2) of the Investment Company Act to permit the deduction of mortality and expense risk charges in connection with the issuance of individual single purchase payment deferred variable annuity contracts.
