U.S. SECURITIES AND EXCHANGE COMMISSION

CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

DOUGLASS F. DURHAM ENJOINED

The Fort Worth Regional Office announced that on April 8 Judge Sidney A. Fitzwater, U.S. District Court for the Northern District of Texas, Dallas Division, issued an order of permanent injunction by default against Douglass F. Durham, of Sarasota, Florida, formerly of Dallas, Texas. The order enjoins Durham from further violations of the registration, broker-dealer registration, and antifraud provisions of the securities laws, and requires him to disgorge \$3.5 million, representing funds raised from investors through the activities alleged in the complaint.

The May 30, 1985 complaint alleged that Durham violated the registration and broker-dealer registration provisions of the securities laws in the offer and sale of securities to the public in the form of fractional undivided working interests in oil and gas wells located in Texas through three companies owned and operated by Durham. From December 1982 through February 1984, Durham raised over \$3.5 million from over 180 investors nationwide. In connection with these offers and sales, the complaint alleged that Durham made fraudulent representations to investors concerning the wells productivity and status, the risks involved, the prior success of his companies, and other matters. The complaint further alleged that Durham misrepresented investor funds for his benefit and three computer companies with which he was associated. (SEC v. Douglas F. Durham, Civil Action No. 3-86-1455-D, NDTX, Dallas Division). (LR-11412)

ARTHUR R. BUCCI ENJOINED

The Atlanta Regional and Miami Branch Offices announced that on April 14 the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of Florida entered a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction against Arthur R. Bucci, enjoining him from further violations of the registration and antifraud provisions of the Securities Act of 1933 and the antifraud provisions of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, and aiding and abetting violations of the broker-dealer registration provisions of the Exchange Act. Bucci consented to the Final Judgment without admitting or denying the allegations in the complaint.

The March 20 complaint filed against James R. Bramble and Bucci alleged violations of the registration and antifraud provisions of the securities laws in the offer and sale of securities in the form of interests in stallion/broodmare syndications, and aiding and abetting violations of the broker-dealer registration provisions. The Commission sought injunctive relief against the defendants and disgorgement by Bramble. (SEC v. James R. Bramble and Arthur R. Bucci, Case No. 87-6203-CIV-ROETTGER). (LR-11413)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

BANKERS NATIONAL LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until May 18 to request a hearing on an application filed by Bankers National Life Insurance Company, Bankers National Variable Account C, and BNL Securities, Inc., for an order granting exemptions from the provisions of Sections 2(a)(35) and 27(a)(1) of the Investment Company Act and paragraphs (b)(1), (b)(13)(i)(B), (c)(2), (c)(4), and (c)(4)(vii) of Rule 6e-3(T) in connection with the issuance of certain flexible premium variable life insurance contracts. (Rel. IC-15698 - April 22)

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until May 18 to request a hearing on an application filed by The Sumitomo Bank of Canada, for an order permitting it to issue U.S. dollar denominated certificates of deposit and other debt securities in the United States. (Rel. IC-15699 - April 23)

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission granted accelerated approval to a proposed rule change filed by The Philadelphia Stock Exchange (SR-Phlx-87-12) to extend to May 16, 1987 the stock options pilot program providing for four expiration months, including two near term months, for the January cycle options. (Rel. 34-24375)

NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Philadelphia Stock Exchange filed a proposed rule change under Rule 19b-4 (SR-Phlx-87-9) to require specialists and registered options traders to make ten-up markets under certain circumstances. Publication of the proposal is expected to be made in the Federal Register during the week of April 27. (Rel. 34-24378)

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Commission approved proposed rule changes filed by: The American Stock Exchange (SR-Amex-87-1) to amend Amex Rule 618 relating to the schedule of fees to be deposited by parties in connection with arbitration claims filed with the Amex. (Rel. 34-24379) and The Pacific Stock Exchange (SR-PSE-86-34) to amend its Equity Floor Procedure Advices. The amendments would prohibit certain conduct on the PSE's Equity Trading Floors, increase the fines for violations of the Advices, and require badges to be worn on the PSE's Los Angeles Equity Trading Floor. (Rel. 34-24380)
