ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

JERALD NEWMAN BARRED

The Commission instituted and settled administrative proceedings against Jerald Newman under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. The Commission accepted Newman's Offer of Settlement in which he consented to an order barring him from association with any broker or dealer, municipal securities dealer, investment company, or investment adviser with the right to reapply for a non-supervisory position after the greater of five years or any period of incarceration, probation or other penal sanction, and/or parole imposed in connection with pending criminal proceedings. After expiration of a two-year period of association in a non-supervisory capacity, Newman may reapply to become associated in any capacity with the aforementioned entities. The proceedings were instituted and settled simultaneous with a permanent injunction [see LR-11435]. (Rel. 34-24457)

CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

JERALD NEWMAN ENJOINED

The Chicago Regional Office announced that on May 7 U.S. District Court Judge Thomas Curran, Eastern District of Wisconsin, entered a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction by Consent against Jerald Newman, enjoining him from future violations, as a principal or aider and abettor, of the registration and antifraud provisions of the securities laws, and from direct violations of Section 15(a)(1) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934.

The February 27, 1986 complaint alleged that Newman violated and aided and abetted violations of the registration and antifraud provisions in the form of secured and unsecured promissory notes of Newmanties Companies, Inc. (Newman Co.) from at least January 1982 to about October 5, 1984. It also alleged that during this period, Newman Co. raised approximately \$11 million from about 800 investors in at least two states through the sale of unsecured and secured promissory notes. It further alleged that, in connection with these sales, Newman, president and treasurer of Newman Co., made and caused to be made to investors, material misrepresentations and omissions regarding the use of investor proceeds, the financial condition of Newman Co., and the collateral securing the secured promissory notes. (SEC v. Jerald Newman and Frank Manders, EDWI, Civil Action No. 86-C-0215). (LR-11435)

INJUNCTIVE RELIEF SOUGHT AGAINST N. NORMAN MULLER AND AMERICAN LAND COMPANY

The Commission today filed an action in the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of New York seeking injunctive relief against N. Norman Muller. The Commission alleges that Muller issued and disseminated an acquisition offer containing materially false and misleading statements concerning his financial ability to acquire all the outstanding shares of Talley Industries, Inc. (SEC v. N. Norman Muller, USDC SDNY, Civil Action No. 87-3669). (LR-11443)

The Commission also filed today a separate action in the U.S. District Court for the District of Columbia seeking injunctive and other relief against Muller and American Land Company (ALC). The Commission alleges that ALC, aided and abetted by Muller, Chairman of ALC's Board of Directors, violated the reporting and books and records provisions of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. The Commission also alleges that Muller violated Section 16(a) of the Exchange Act by failing to file required forms disclosing his beneficial ownership of ALC common stock and all changes in such ownership. (SEC v. American Land Company and N. Norman Muller, USDC DC, Civil Action No. 87-1453). (LR-11443)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

ROBERT T. SHAW

An order has been issued granting Robert T. Shaw, I.C.H. Financial Services, Inc., and Southwestern Life Insurance Company an exemption from Sections 9(a)(2) and (3) of the Investment Company Act to the extent applicable by virtue of the entry of the permanent injunction against Shaw in SEC v. The American Foundation for Advanced Education of Arkansas. (Rel. IC-15754 - May 27)

BANKERS NATIONAL LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until June 22 to request a hearing on an application filed by Bankers National Life Insurance Company, Bankers National Variable Account B, Bankers National Variable Account C, and Bankers National Series Trust seeking an order to permit the substitution of shares of the Mortgage-Backed Securities Portfolio for shares of the Government Securities Portfolio in order to preserve the existing tax status of certain variable contracts in light of temporary regulations issued by the Internal Revenue Service. (Rel. IC-15755 - May 27)

HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

CNG PRODUCING COMPANY

A supplemental order has been issued authorizing CNG Producing Company and CNG Development Company, subsidiaries of Consolidated Natural Gas Company, a to increase from \$475,000 to a maximum of \$1,600,000 the amount of a letter of credit which Producing was authorized to obtain by orders dated October 1, 1985 [Rel. 35-23848] and May 7, 1986 [Rel. 35-24090]. (Rel. 35-24396 - May 22)

GEORGIA POWER COMPANY

An order has been issued authorizing Georgia Power Company, subsidiary of The Southern Company, to issue and sell on or before December 31, 1988, up to \$850 million of first mortgage bonds, preferred stock and/or collateral pollution control revenue bonds in any combination of issuance. Georgia will use up to \$500 million of the resulting sales proceeds to refund securities, unless otherwise ordered by the Commission. Jurisdiction is reserved over the remaining \$350 million of sale proceeds, for uses other than refunding, until Georgia obtains state approval. Regarding common stock dividend restrictions on first mortgage bonds and collateral pollution control bonds, Georgia has also been authorized to use March 31, 1984 as the starting date for the accumulation of earned surplus under its indentures, with a resulting dividend allowance of \$302 million. SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed by: The New York Stock Exchange (SR-NYSE-86-24) that would reposition certain Exchange Constitutional provisions concerning arbitration, revise its schedule of arbitration fees, and adopt, for a one-year pilot period, a new rule requiring contesting parties to an arbitration hearing to exchange documents ten days prior to the scheduled hearing date. (Rel. 34-24489); The Pacific Stock Exchange (SR-PSE-87-4) requireing members and member firms to notify the Exchange of any changes in their respective addresses within 60 days of such change. (Rel. 34-24490); The Philadelphia Stock Exchange (SR-Phlx-87-8) modifying its

procedures regarding exemptions from position and exercise limits. (Rel. 34-24491); and (SR-Phlx-86-41) establishing new Specialist Allocation and Evaluation rules until November 30, 1987 and also amending its Option Floor Procedure Advices to establish a fine schedule for floor brokers who fail to complete the options evaluation questionnaire. (Rel. 34-24496)

IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Midwest Stock Exchange filed a proposed rule change which became effective upon filing under Section 19(b)(3)(A) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. The proposal (SR-MSE-87-7) amends MSE rules to exempt temporarily from its transaction fees transactions on the MSE in NMS securities traded on an unlisted basis. The exemption will continue until July 31, 1987. (Rel. 34-24495)
