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## CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

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### LIQUIDATION ORDERED OF UNREGISTERED INVESTMENT COMPANY

The Fort Worth Regional Office announced that on May 26 a civil action was instituted in the Federal District Court in Fayetteville, Arkansas, against Quillin Porter and Equity Investors of Arkansas, Inc. (EIA). The Complaint seeks injunctive relief, prohibiting Porter and EIA from engaging in further violations of Section 7 of the Investment Company Act of 1940, and the appointment of a Trustee, under Section 42(e) of the Act, to liquidate EIA, an unregistered investment company said to have raised in excess of \$5 million from 258 or more investors residing in at least 20 states.

On May 26, the Court entered temporary restraining orders, and on May 27, the Court issued an order appointing a Trustee to liquidate EIA. (SEC v. Quillin Porter, et al., USDC WDAR, Civil Action No. 87-5068, Waters, J.). (LR-11448)

### TRUSTEE APPOINTED FOR GOVERNMENT SECURITIES CORP.

The Atlanta Regional and Miami Branch Offices and the Securities Investor Protection Corporation announced that on May 12 U.S. District Judge Alcee L. Hastings, Southern District of Florida, entered an Order and Protective Decree, adjudicating that the customers of Government Securities Corporation (GSC) were in need of the protection provided by the Securities Investor Protection Act and appointing John R. Camp, Jr., Esq., of Miami, Florida, as trustee for the liquidation of GSC's business. GSC, located in Coral Gables, Florida, was registered with the Commission as a broker-dealer. GSC did business primarily trading GNMA certificates to retail customers.

SIPC's Complaint and Application, filed May 12, alleged that GSC was in danger of failing to meet customer obligations and was not in compliance with Section 17(a) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rules 17a-3, 17a-4, and 17a-11 in that, among other things, GSC failed to maintain accurate and complete books and records. GSC consented to the Order and Protective Decree without admitting or denying any allegations in the Complaint and Application. (SIPC v. Government Securities Corporation, Civil Action No. 87-910-CIV-Kehoe, SDFL, filed May 12, 1987). (LR-11449)

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## INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

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### THE PENN MUTUAL LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until June 26 to request a hearing on an application by The Penn Mutual Life Insurance Company, Penn Mutual Variable Life Account I, and Penn Mutual Equity Services, Inc. for an order exempting them from the provisions of Sections 2(a)(32), 22(c), 27(c)(1), and 27(d) of the Investment Company Act and Rules 6e-3(T)(b)(12)(ii), 6e-3(T)(b)(13)(iv), and 22c-1. The exemption will permit the uncollected portion of the periodic charge made for premium taxes incurred in connection with the issuance of the Contract to be deducted from the amount otherwise payable upon surrender of the Contract during the first nine contract years. 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## HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

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### FLORIDA GAS TRANSMISSION

An order has been issued declaring that Florida Gas Transmission Company, subsidiary of Citrus Corporation, both Delaware corporations, is not a gas utility company under Section 2(a)(4) of the Public Utility Holding Company Act of 1935. (Rel. 35-24402 - June 1)

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## SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

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### APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed by the Pacific Stock Exchange (SR-PSE-87-6) to enable it to issue rights to purchase special memberships. (Rel. 34-24516)

### NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

Proposed rule changes have been filed under Rule 19b-4 by: The Chicago Board Options Exchange (SR-CBOE-87-7) to require firms to apply and register as stock execution services and to establish certain business practices and recordkeeping obligations therefor. (Rel. 34-24517); (SR-CBOE-87-21) relating to changes to its schedule of arbitration fee deposits. (Rel. 34-24518); and (SR-CBOE-87-18) to establish a two-year modified trading system pilot program that would implement designated primary market-makers in certain new options classes and foreign currency options classes. (Rel. 34-24520); and the National Securities Clearing Corporation (SR-NSCC-87-6) amending its Procedures to include a Reconfirmation and Pricing Service. The purpose of the rule change is to adopt, for a one-time pilot use, a system to reconfirm and reprice municipal securities trades that have not settled in a timely fashion. (Rel. 34-24519)

Publication of the proposals are expected to be made in the Federal Register during the week of June 1.

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## TRUST INDENTURE ACT RELEASES

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### CITICORP

An order has been issued under the Trust Indenture Act of 1939 on an application by Citicorp that the trusteeship of United States Trust Company of New York under four

existing, previously qualified indentures, and under two pooling and servicing agreements dated January 1, 1987 under which certificates evidencing interests in a pool of mortgage loans have been issued, is not so likely to involve a material conflict of interest as to make it necessary to disqualify the Trust Company from acting as trustee under any of the indentures or agreements. Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
