RULES AND RELATED MATTERS

COMMENTS REQUESTED ON RULE 19b-1

The Commission is proposing for public comment an amendment to Rule 19b-1 under the Investment Company Act of 1940. The proposal would allow certain registered investment companies to make one additional distribution of long-term capital gains with respect to a taxable year where failure to make the distribution may result in the assessment of a special excise tax. The Commission also proposes technical changes to the rule to correct certain references to the Internal Revenue Code.

COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

SAB NO. 70

The Commission has issued Staff Accounting Bulletin No. 70, expressing the staff's views relative to the accounting and balance sheet presentation for non-recourse debt that is collateralized by lease receivables and/or the related leased assets. It also deletes certain interpretations published in Staff Accounting Bulletin No. 52 relative to recognition of gains on terminations of overfunded defined benefit pension plans. These interpretations are no longer relevant because of accounting standards adopted by the Financial Accounting Standards Board. (Rel. SAB-70)

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

PROCEEDINGS INSTITUTED AGAINST KIDDER, PEABODY & CO. INCORPORATED

The Commission instituted public administrative proceedings as to Kidder, Peabody & Co. Incorporated under Section 15(b)(4) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. Simultaneous with the institution of these proceedings, Kidder submitted an Offer of Settlement for the purpose of disposing of the issues raised by those proceedings.

In accepting Kidder's Offer of Settlement, the Commission found that Kidder had been permanently enjoined by the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of New York from future violations of the margin, antifraud, and books and records provisions of the Exchange Act [Sections 7(c), 10(b), 14(e), and 17(a)(1)] and from aiding and abetting future violations of the net capital and books and records provisions of the Exchange Act [Sections 15(c)(3) and 17(a)(1)].

Based upon those findings, the Commission ordered that Kidder be censured and comply with its undertakings to implement certain procedures to prevent and detect violations of the securities laws and the rules and regulations of self-regulatory organizations, including retaining a consultant to review its policies and procedures and not resuming risk arbitrage trading activities before adopting the procedures recommended by the consultant and special compliance procedures pertaining to risk arbitrage trading. CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

CIVIL INJUNCTIVE ACTION FILED AGAINST KIDDER, PEABODY & CO. INCORPORATED

The Commission filed a civil injunctive action on June 4 against Kidder, Peabody & Co. Incorporated, an investment bank and registered broker-dealer, alleging that it traded securities while in possession of material nonpublic information received from an arbitrageur at another New York City investment bank and illegally "parked" securities on behalf of entities controlled by Ivan F. Boesky and that, as a result of these activities, Kidder violated or aided and abetted violations of the antifraud, margin, net capital, and books and records provisions of the securities laws.

Without admitting or denying the allegations of the Complaint, Kidder consented to a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction and Other Relief requiring it, among other things, to disgorge \$13,676,101 in illegal trading profits and to pay a civil penalty of \$11,618,674 to the U.S. Treasury under the Insider Trading Sanctions Act of 1984. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

KIDDER, PEABODY & CO., INCORPORATED

GENERAL ELECTRIC COMPANY

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until June 29 to request a hearing on an application filed by General Electric Company (GE) and General Electric Investment Corporation for an order exempting them and all companies (as defined in the Investment Company Act) which are directly or indirectly controlled by GE, other than Kidder, Peabody Group Inc., Kidder, Peabody & Co. Incorporated, or any company controlled by Group or Kidder, from the provisions of Section 9(a) of the Investment Company Act respecting the circumstances described in the application. In addition, a temporary order has been issued granting the requested relief until the Commission takes final action on the application for an order permanently exempting the above entities from the provisions of Section 9(a).
