ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

STOP ORDER ISSUED AGAINST LOWTECH, INCORPORATED

The Commission issued a Findings and Stop Order by Default suspending the S-18 registration statement filed by LowTech, Incorporated, headquartered in Boston, Massachusetts. The registration, filed in the Commission's Boston Regional Office, involved a blank check offering seeking to raise a minimum of \$100,000 and a maximum of \$500,000.

The Order found that the registration statement contained false and misleading statements, and omissions of material statements regarding, among other things: (1) legal representation of LowTech; (2) the accountants' report; (3) background of the principals; (4) authenticity of the signature of one of the principals; (5) location of the issuer and its principals; and (6) failure to cooperate in the examination authorized by the Commission under Section 8(e) of the Securities Act of 1933. EATON VANCE CALIFORNIA MUNICIPALS TRUST

Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
