ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

ROBERT J. CHECK SUSPENDED

Chief Administrative law Judge Warren E. Blair issued an initial decision suspending Robert J. Check, of Avon, Connecticut, from association with any broker or dealer for 30 days.

Judge Blair found that Check, in violation of Section 15(b)(4)(E) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, failed reasonably to supervise salesmen of a registered broker-dealer who were subject to his supervision with a view to preventing violations of Section 17(a)(2) of the Securities Act of 1933.

DECISION BARRING EUGENE MULVIHILL FINAL

The decision of an administrative law judge barring Eugene Mulvihill, of New Vernon, New Jersey, from association with any broker or dealer has become final.

According to the law judge's decision, Mulvihill controls two registered broker-dealers. In 1984, he was convicted of using a corporation to promote a criminal purpose; doing business as an unauthorized insurance company; and tampering with and falsifying records. In order to avoid the cost of premiums for insurance required by various companies with which he was involved, Mulvihill formed an offshore corporation and utilized it to issue and distribute fictitious insurance policies and performance bonds. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

COMPAGNIE FINANCIERE DE PARIBAS
