ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

PROCEEDINGS INSTITUTED AND SETTLED AGAINST ROBERT L. BEVILL, OTHERS

The Commission instituted and settled public administrative proceedings and imposed sanctions against Robert L. Bevill, John P. Rooney, and Robert S. Levine, all former principals of Bevill, Bresler & Schulman, Inc. (BBS), a registered broker-dealer. Simultaneously, respondents submitted Offers of Settlement which the Commission accepted.

In its Order, the Commission made findings to which respondents consented without admitting or denying them. The Commission found that respondents, among other illegal practices, caused BBS to enter into government security repurchase agreements wherein the government securities underlying the agreements were either already sold in other repurchase agreements or were customer-owned, fully paid for, and purportedly held in a safekeeping account for the customer. The Commission also found that they aided and abetted BBS in violation of recordkeeping and net capital requirements.

The Commission imposed sanctions which bars respondents from association in any capacity with any broker, dealer, investment company, investment adviser, or municipal securities dealer.

Bevill, Rooney, and Levine also consented to permanent injunctions, enjoining them from violating the antifraud provisions. (Rel. 34-24658)

CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

DENNIS GILLETTE ENJOINED

The Commission today filed a complaint in the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of Florida seeking injunctive and other relief against Dennis Gillette, an officer of Sensormatic Electronics Corp. The complaint alleges that Gillette sold short Sensormatic stock while in possession of material, nonpublic information that Sensormatic's earnings for its third quarter of 1984 would be lower than anticipated. The complaint further alleges that Gillette failed to report to the Commission his short sale and subsequent purchase of Sensormatic stock and that he maintained the short position longer than is legally permissible.

Simultaneous with the filing of the complaint, Gillette without admitting or denying the complaint's allegations, consented to a permanent injunction prohibiting him from future violation of the antifraud and certain filing provisions of the securities laws. [This matter was referred to the Commission by the National Association of Securities Dealers.] (SEC v. Dennis Gillette, USDC SDFL, Broward County Division, Civil Action No. 87 Civ 6558). (LR-11502)

INJUNCTIVE, OTHER RELIEF SOUGHT AGAINST MICHAEL CLINGER, OTHERS

The Commission today filed an action in the U.S. District Court for the District of Columbia for injunctive and other relief against Michael Clinger, Walter G. Solomon, and Avi Oren, formerly the principal officers of Endo-Lase Inc., of New York, New York. The Commission requested that the Court permanently enjoin the defendants from violating antifraud provisions of the Securities Act of 1933 and the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rules under the Exchange Act prohibiting misrepresentations to accountants and the falsification of accounting records and from aiding and abetting violations of the periodic reporting and internal controls provisions of that Act. The Commission is also seeking other relief including disgorgement of certain gains.

In its complaint, the Commission alleged, among other things, that as a part of a fraudulent course of conduct, the defendants caused Endo-Lase to issue false and misleading financial statements in which its revenues, net income, accounts receivable and shareholders' equity were materially overstated. The defendants consented to the final judgments without admitting or denying the allegations in the Commission's complaint. (SEC v. Michael Clinger, et al., USDC DC, Civil Action No. 87-2070). INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

ML-LEE ACQUISITION FUND, L.P.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until August 11 to request a hearing on an application filed by ML-Lee Acquisition Fund, L.P. (Partnership), a business development company, Mezzanine Investments, L. P. (Managing General Partner), and Thomas H. Lee Advisors, Inc. (Investment Adviser), for an order for a determination that the independent general partners of the Partnership are not, within the meaning of Section 2(a)(19) of the Investment Company Act "interested persons" of the Partnership, the Managing General Partner, the Investment Adviser or Merrill Lynch Pierce, Fenner & Smith Incorporated. (Rel. IC-15890 - July 22)

BOSTON FINANCIAL QUALIFIED HOUSING LIMITED PARTNERSHIP

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until August 13 to request a hearing on an application filed by Boston Financial Qualified Housing Limited Partnership (formerly, Boston Financial Tax Credit Registered Placement, L.P.), a limited partnership organized under the Delaware Uniform Limited Partnership Act, and its managing general partner, 29 Franklin Street, Inc., a Massachusetts corporation, exempting the Partnership from all provisions of the Investment Company Act. The Partnership will operate as a "two-tier" partnership, by investing in other limited partnerships that in turn will engage in the development, ownership and operation of housing for low and moderate income persons. (Rel. IC-15891 - July 22)

COMPAGNIE FINANCIERE de PARIBAS

An order has been issued amending a previous order permitting Compagnie Financiere de Paribas to issue its equity securities in the United States. (Rel. IC-15982 - July 23)

HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

APPALACHIAN POWER COMPANY

An order has been issued authorizing Appalachian Power Company, subsidiary of American Electric Power Company, Inc., and its subsidiaries (Coal Subsidiaries), Southern Appalachian Coal Company, Central Appalachian Coal Company, and Cedar Coal Company, whereby the Coal Subsidiaries will pay dividends to Appalachian in proportion to their respective shares of an aggregate capital surplus of \$58.4 million. (Rel. 35-24429 - July 23)

GEORGIA POWER COMPANY

A supplemental order has been issued authorizing Georgia Power Company, a registered holding company, to finance pollution control facilities in an amount up to \$90 million. (Rel. 35-24430 - July 23)

LISTING, DELISTING AND UNLISTED TRADING ACTIONS

WITHDRAWAL SOUGHT

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until August 12 to comment on the application of OZARK HOLDINGS, INC. to withdraw the 9-3/4% convertible subordinated debentures, due October 1, 2010, from listing and registration on the American Stock Exchange. (Rel. 34-24728)

WITHDRAWAL GRANTED

An order has been issued granting the application of ROCKAWAY CORPORATION to withdraw the common stock, no par value, from listing and registration on the American Stock Exchange. (Rel. 34-24729)

UNLISTED TRADING GRANTED

An order has been issued granting the application of the Philadelphia Stock Exchange for unlisted trading privileges in the common stock of three issues which are listed and registered on one or more other national securities exchanges and are reported in the consolidated transaction reporting system. SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVENESS OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

A proposed rule change filed by the Midwest Clearing Corporation became effective upon filing under Rule 19b-4. The proposal (SR-MCC-87-4) establishes procedures for MCC's Automated Customer Account Transfer Service. (Rel. 34-24724)

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed by The Options Clearing Corporation (SR-OCC-86-10) to allow qualifying non-U.S. securities firms to participate directly in OCC as long as they comply with the financial standards of their home country. (Rel. 34-24725)

TRUST INDENTURE ACT RELEASES

CITICORP

An order has been issued under the Trust Indenture Act of 1939 on an application by Citicorp that the trusteeship of United States Trust Company of New York under four existing indentures and under two Pooling and Servicing Agreements, each dated April 1, 1987 under which certificates evidencing interests in a pool of mortgage loans have been issued, is not so likely to involve a material conflict of interest as to make it necessary to disqualify the Trust Company from acting as trustee.
