REPROPOSAL OF REVISED RULE 701, NEW TEMPORARY RULES 702 AND 703, AND A REVISED FORM 701

The Commission is reproposing for comment a revised Rule 701, new temporary Rules 702 and 703, and a revised Form 701 to provide an exemption from the registration requirements of the Securities Act of 1933 for offers and sales of securities pursuant to employee benefit plans or compensation contracts of issuers that are not subject to the reporting requirements of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934.

TWO ALTERNATIVE VERSIONS OF NEW RULE 433 PROPOSED FOR COMMENT
