ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

STOP ORDER PROCEEDINGS INSTITUTED AGAINST PIONEER VENTURE CORPORATION AND WILDERNESS ELECTRONICS, INC.

The Commission issued an Order Fixing Time and Place of Public Hearing under Section 8(d) of the Securities Act of 1933 to determine whether a Stop Order should be issued suspending the effectiveness of the registration statement of Pioneer Venture Corporation as amended by Pioneer Venture Corporation and Wilderness Electronics, Inc. (WEI).

The hearing was held at 10:00 a.m. September 9 at Commission headquarters.

The Commission initiated the proceeding because of alleged untrue, false, and misleading statements made in and omissions in the first and second post-effective amendments to the registration statement concerning, among other things, WEI's termination for default on a \$2.3 million government contract; and a \$216,000 obligation against which future deliveries by WEI are to be offset. ORDER INSTITUTING PROCEEDINGS AND IMPOSING REMEDIAL SANCTIONS AGAINST KIM D. RUST

The Commission ordered public administrative proceedings under Sections 15(b) and 19(h) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 against Kim D. Rust, formerly a principal, 25% shareholder and registered representative with OTC Net, Inc., a defunct Denver-based broker-dealer presently in SIPC-supervised liquidation. The Commission found that Rust: (1) was convicted, pursuant to a plea of guilty, on April 29, 1985 of one count of securities fraud in violation of Colorado Revised Statute 11-51-123; and (2) on August 7, 1987 was permanently enjoined in the U.S. District Court for the District of Colorado, pursuant to his consent and without admitting or denying the allegations of the Commission's complaint, from violations of the antifraud, registration, and books and records provisions of the securities laws.

The order bars Rust from associating in any capacity with any broker, dealer, investment company, investment adviser, or municipal securities dealer, provided that after four years she may apply to become reassociated in a supervised, non-supervisory, and non-proprietary capacity. (Rel. 34-24868)

CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

CONTEMPT FILED AGAINST ROYALE GROUP, LTD. AND LEONARD A. PELULLO

The Commission today filed a Motion in the U.S. District Court for the District of Columbia seeking an order adjudging The Royale Group, Ltd., of Miami Beach, Florida, and Leonard A. Pelullo, its Chief Executive Officer, Chairman of the Board, and President in civil contempt for Royale's failure to file its annual and quarterly reports since March 1985. Royale, formerly known as Cavanagh Communities Corporation, was enjoined from failing to file complete and timely annual and quarterly reports in an action brought by the Commission in August 1982. [See LR-9741, August 27, 1982.]

The Order would require Royale to file its delinquent reports by September 30. In the event Royale fails to file its required reports by September 30, the Order would require Pelullo personally to pay a fine of \$1,000 each day thereafter until the reports are filed.

Royale and Pelullo each consented to the Order, which has not yet been entered. (SEC v. The Royale Group, Ltd., Civil Action No. 82-2415-HHG, USDC DC). (LR-11535)

An order has been issued on an application of The Equitable Funds (Fund), Equico Securities, Inc., Alliance Fund Distributors, Inc., Alliance Capital Reserves, Alliance Government Reserves, and Alliance Tax-Exempt Reserves (collectively, Alliance Funds) (1) permitting the present and future series of the Fund to assess, defer, and waive a contingent deferred sales charge; (2) approving certain offers of exchange among the Fund and Alliance Funds; and (3) approving certain joint transactions in connection with such exchange offers.
