COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

SEC FILES BRIEF IN NEWMONT MINING CORP. V. PICKENS

General Counsel Daniel L. Goelzer announced yesterday that the Commission filed with the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Ninth Circuit in San Francisco, a friend of the court brief in Newmont Mining Corp. v. Pickens. The brief, which was filed in response to a request by the court, argues that there is no requirement under the Williams Act, which is the federal securities law regulating tender offers, that a tender offeror have firm financing commitments in place before it begins its offer.

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

GW UTILITIES LIMITED

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until October 26 to request a hearing on an application filed by GW Utilities Limited for an order declaring it not to be an investment company, or, alternatively, for an order exempting it from all provisions of the Investment Company Act and rules and regulations thereunder. An order has also been issued exempting Applicant from all provisions of the Act from July 25, 1987 until the Commission shall make a final determination on the application. (Rel. IC-16027 - Oct. 2)

THE GERMANY FUND, INC.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until October 27 to request a hearing on an application filed by Pilgrim Government Securities Fund, Pilgrim High Income Fund, and Pilgrim International Bond Fund, open-end, diversified management investment companies, organized as limited partnerships, for an order amending an existing order (Rel. IC-15507, December 30, 1986) to exempt existing and future individual Managing General Partners of Applicants from the provisions of Section 2(a)(19) of the Investment Company Act to the extent they are interested persons solely due to their status as partners of Applicants. HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

ALLEGHENY POWER SYSTEM, INC.

An order has been issued authorizing Allegheny Power System, Inc., a registered holding company, to issue and sell up to \$110 million of bank notes and commercial paper through September 30, 1989. Allegheny has been authorized to issue and sell the commercial paper pursuant to an exception from competitive bidding requirements. (Rel. 35-24467 - Sept. 29)

Companies and individuals must report to the Commission within ten days on Schedule 13D if after the acquisition of equity securities of a public company their beneficial interest therein exceeds five percent. Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
